Picking up your student during the school day?

Here is what you need to know.

- 1. All MVHS Students are required to have a parent/guardian or a person listed on their Emergency Contact Form come in to the Attendance Office (Front Office at Lincoln) to pick them up.
- 2. Identification is required to sign student out.
- 3. Student will be called out of class.
- 4. A note of students absence must be turned in within 48 hours listing students name, date of absence and reason.

This MVHS Policy is required of all students regardless of grade, age or whether they drive. Parents may come in, meet with an administration and complete a waiver if they would like an exception to this policy.
