MVSD offers Diagnostic COVID-19 Testing

Diagnostic COVID-19 testing is available for all staff, students and families within the Mount Vernon School District. Testing will be free, available Monday through Friday from 1pm-5pm on a walk up basis and located at: MVSD Community Transitions Building, 2120 N. LaVenture Rd., Mount Vernon. Reminder: Masks are Required!

Regardless of vaccination status, all school personnel, volunteers, visitors, and students **must** wear cloth face coverings, or an acceptable alternative (e.g., surgical mask or clear face shield with a drape) at school when indoors or on busses. This is an order from the WA State Secretary of Health.

Picking up your student during the school day?

- 1.All MVHS Students are required to have a parent/guardian or a person listed on their Emergency Contact Form come in to the Attendance Office (Front Office at Lincoln) to pick them up.
- 2.Identification is required to sign student out.
- 3.Student will be called out of class.
- 4.A note of students absence must be turned in within 48 hours listing students name, date of absence & reason. This MVHS Policy is required of all students regardless of grade, age or whether they drive. Parents may come in, meet with an administration and complete a waiver if they would like an exception to this policy.
