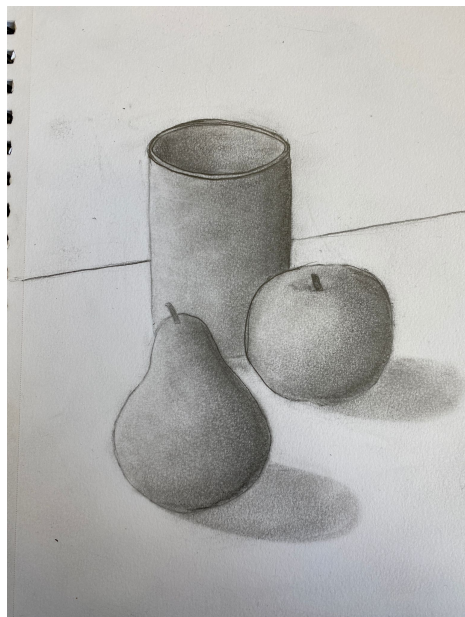
February 11th is the Last Day to Purchase a Yearbook!
