**MASK MANDATE**

Governor Inslee announced that the state's indoor mask mandate will be lifted beginning March 12, 2022. This includes inside our schools and on our school buses. **This means that beginning Monday, March 14**, masks will be optional for students and staff in our schools and on our buses. Masks remain a requirement for all students, staff, volunteers, and visitors inside our schools and on school buses through March 11.
